☛ **Quartermaster's Coin:** You've done a big favor for an ancient quartermaster of the Royal Army. Ollie has gifted you with a Quartermaster's Coin. The front or “heads” side has a bas-relief wagon with supplies and the Ulek symbol as wheels. “Serving the Principality on the road” is inscribed around the wagon. The reverse or “tails” side has dwarven runes that signify two centuries of service. Superimposed over the runes is a bas-relief of a single-masted ship in one section a marine's trident in another, a crossbow in a third and a wagon in the last to represent Ollie's service to the Principality of Ulek. “Reclaim Ulek! One way or another” is inscribed around the engraving. The use of this favor will appear in a future event.
