LIN'S NOODLE SHOP

A small restaurant is nestled between a bakery and a carpenter's workshop. The tired adventures smile as they recognize a wooden sign picturing a bowl of noodles hanging above the door. They sit at the bar and are served steaming bowls of noodle soup by the dark haired owner. "Delicious as always" says the fighter, "I'm glad you guys have a shop here".

The Lin family immigrated from an Asiatic country and started a noodle shop. When the children grew up, they dispersed and started shops of their own. Now, several generations later, a Lin's noodle shop can be found in most major cities and some large towns. Because their family name precedes their given name when introduced, some people think that the owners are all named Lin.

The noodle shop can provide the same opportunities that a tavern does for the introduction of NPCs or plot hooks.

Inside the shop, a tall counter with stools for customers is located in front of the cooking area. There are also a number of small round tables scatted around the rest of the dining area.

Customers can be offered chopsticks instead of a spoon. If they choose chopsticks you can have them roll DEX to determine how successful they are at using them, or if they make a fool of themselves. They can also choose to justify with their backstory why they know how to use chopsticks.

MENU

The restaurants serve udon type noodle soup in clear broth, which can be topped with vegetables, meat or eggs. Some stores offer the noodles fried rather than in soup. They also offer green tea to drink with the meal.
