SHOU-CHIANG: THE SHOU ALPHABET

The 24 characters of the Shou Chiang are the basis for written communication throughout Shou Lung. The characters have been refined and developed for thousands of years, and many nations have adopted variations of them. Shou is written from top to bottom, left to right. The numeric system of Shou Chiang is simple, and easily transferred to the abacus, a common counting tool in the Em

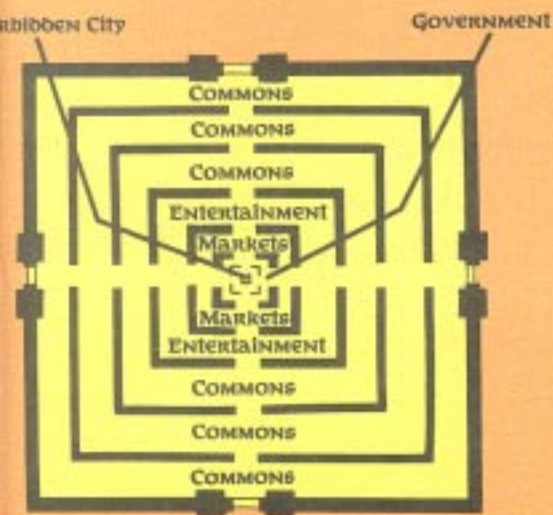

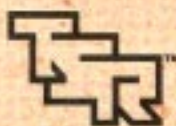
